

## CAN – Environmental Policy

CAN\* is an ISO 14001: 2004 registered company (cert. E8305) having achieved registration of its Environmental Management System on May 2<sup>nd</sup> 2013. This policy statement is communicated to all staff and subcontractors and available to the public.

The company is aware of its interaction with the physical environment across a wide range of specialist technical services provided to its clients and has established a register of its most significant environmental aspects which is reviewed regularly by the management team.

CAN is committed to protection of the environment and prevention of pollution of the physical environment through careful management of its offices, stores and operational activities. CAN is also committed to continual improvement of its EMS through setting and reviewing appropriate objectives, targets and programmes, with a view to enhancing its environmental performance.

Key environmental objectives have specific targets (KPIs) set against them and are reviewed regularly to ensure progress is in line with the CAN Business Plan. These objectives go beyond the company's commitment to fulfilling its compliance obligations, with the aim of achieving a more sustainable approach to the provision of CAN's client-specific solutions as follows:

- Energy Reduction: Complete the implementation of energy reduction measures across company premises (office and stores), increase energy awareness and continue energy monitoring.
- Fleet Emissions: Monitor CO<sub>2</sub> emissions for all company cars and vans with the aim of achieving year on year reductions in fleet emissions.
- Select vehicles with lower NO<sub>2</sub> emissions for use primarily in urban areas.
- Continue to review the effectiveness of hybrid/electric vehicles with a view to their introduction into the fleet once they are considered sufficiently robust and cost effective in use.
- New Plant/Vehicles: Carefully review and set specifications for future plant and vehicles ahead of purchasing and/or leasing, in order to minimise emissions.
- Waste minimisation and recycling: Maintain current good practices and monitor waste production company-wide with a view to continual reduction of waste to landfill and increase in recycled waste volume.
- Encourage all staff and Clients to undertake meetings, where appropriate, by means of video conferencing to reduce journeys, thereby lowering our carbon footprint.
